New at the Library:

Additional Online Journal

Access: Searching using the Search EBSCOhost box at the top of the library page just got much better. We have added Academic Search Complete, Business Source Complete, SocINDEX with Full Text, Education Research Complete, Art & Architecture Complete, Humanities International Complete, EconLit with Full Text, MEDLINE with Full Text and Political Science Complete to our collection. You can search all of these using the main search box, or choose "search more articles" and select a single database for more controlled searching. We recommend choosing a specific database based on your topic if you don't find several great articles in the first page of results from the search box.

Sundae Sunday: Join us from 3 to 4 pm on Sunday, August 23rd for a short tour of the library and a make-it-yourself sundae bar. This will be a great chance to take a look around the library, find a great place to study and identify the areas where books and other materials in your area of study are located.

New Faculty Luncheon: Our annual Lunch in the Library is happening on August 18th. Come on over and enjoy a free lunch and meet the staff of the Dulaney-Browne Library. RESEARCH HELP



Research help is available to all students, faculty, and staff. You can ask a librarian for help with research at anytime by just stopping by the information desk, which is located near the front doors. You can also schedule individual or group sessions with a librarian. During these sessions you can receive a tour of the library, introduction to our databases and other resources, or you can have the session customized to your needs. If you have a specific assignment/topic we can design a session that will

INTER-LIBRARY LOAN?

Interlibrary loan (ILL) services are available to all OCU students, faculty, and staff. Interlibrary loan allows you to request materials that the Dulaney-Browne Library does not own. We then check with libraries

across the U.S. and have the books/articles sent to our library where you can then check them out. ILL can take up to 3 weeks, but items normally arrive in 2 weeks or less. Some libraries are willing to fax journal articles, making them available even faster. The standard checkout period for ILL items is 3 weeks and there is a 50¢ per day late charge. You can request ILL items in several ways. You can request items by emailing the title and author information (include journal title for articles) to
