CATALOG REQUESTS



Did you know you can place requests using the library's catalog? You can place the following requests: Get it; 2 Days, Holds, Recalls, and New Book Request.

Get it; 2 Days is the newest of our requests. We will retrieve any book you request and place in our hold shelf. You can pick it up at the circulation desk within 2 days. You can search the catalog from home and find a book, video, or other item you would like to check out. Place a "Get it; 2 Days" request.

The request will be processed by library staff the following morning and your item(s) will be retrieved and placed on our hold shelf. You will then be notified via your OCU e-mail account that the item is ready to be picked up. We will hold the items on the hold shelf for one week.

Holds are intended for items that are already checked out. If you need an item but someone else already has it checked out, you can place a

“hold” on that item. As soon as the item is returned to the library a hold slip prints, notifying library staff to place the item on our hold shelf. You will be contacted via your OCU e-mail that the item is available. You can also place a “recall” on a checked out item. This will automatically send an

e-mail asking the patron who has the item to please return it as soon as possible. The rest of the process works exactly like a hold.

Request New Books is a form you can fill out requesting that the library purchase material we do not already own. These requests are sent directly to the Acquisitions/

Monographs Librarian, Robert Dorman.

How do I place a request? Once you have found an item in the catalog that you want to request you just click the “requests” button at the top of the page. You will be prompted for a login. Type in your OCU ID number minus the “B.” Then type in your last name. (If you are experiencing trouble

logging in, please contact us at 208-5068.) Next, choose the type of request and click “ok.”
