request materials that the Dulaney-Browne Library does not own. We then check with libraries across the U.S. and have the books/articles sent to our library where you can then check them out. ILL can take up to 3 weeks, but items normally arrive in 2 weeks or less. Some libraries are willing to fax

journal articles, making them available even faster. The standard checkout period for ILL items is 3 weeks and there is a 50¢ per day late charge. You can request ILL items in several ways. You can request items by emailing the title and author information (include journal title for articles) to dblill@okcu.edu. You can pick up request forms

at the information desk in the library or you can make a request online by visiting



the library's homepage (<http://www.okcu.edu/library>) and click on the

"borrow items from another library" link on the left hand side of the page. For more information call Ed Bryant at 208-5874.
