**Free Searching of WorldCat & JSTOR:** WorldCat and JSTOR can now be searched together from anywhere for free. Just go to [www.worldcat.org](http://www.worldcat.org). If you are on campus, you can access JSTOR articles that the library subscribes to directly. If we don't have it and you are searching from a computer that the system recognizes as being on the main campus, you will see "you are connected to the Oklahoma City University, Dulaney-Browne Library network" and you can request an interlibrary loan.

**Tax Forms:** The library has some federal tax forms and instructions, including 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, schedule A, and schedule B.
