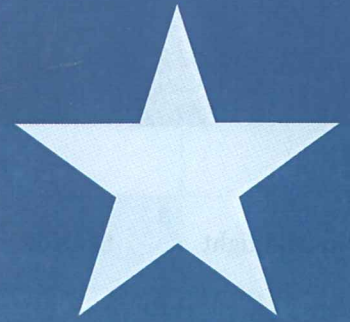

Laptop Ready 1st Floor: The library's first floor has been redesigned to offer more spaces for individual and group work with laptops and easily accessible electrical outlets. Printing from a laptop is easy too. Just ask at the information desk. The library also plans to add more computers soon.

EBSCOHOST VISUAL SEARCH

All of the EBSCOHOST databases have the visual search option, which allows you to narrow broad searches through a point and click method. To access the visual search click on the button in the top middle of the screen labeled "visual search." Next, type in a broad search such as "dance" and click on the "search button." If you scroll down you will see a large gray circle with several smaller colored circles inside. The colored circles will be labeled with subject headings relating to dance. For example, physiology, dance ther-

apy, injuries, dance psychology, etc... Each of the colored circles will have smaller circles inside of them and if you roll your mouse over them their subjects will appear. If you click on dance therapy the graphic will zoom in and make that circle larger. There are more circles inside of the dance therapy circle and inside those circles are more circles. Some of the circles contain squares. The squares represent articles and if you click on a square the article information will appear on the right hand side of the screen.

One of the downsides to the visual search is that once you find an article the terms listed for that article are not clickable. However, the terms are clickable in the normal search feature. If you find that you have clicked on the wrong circle or if you just want to go back to explore some

more subjects there is a link at the top of the graphic labeled "zoom back." The zoom back link will take you up one level. The link next to it is labeled "top level" and it will take you back to the large gray circle. If you have any questions please contact a librarian at 208-5065 or email askalibrarian@okcu.edu.
