

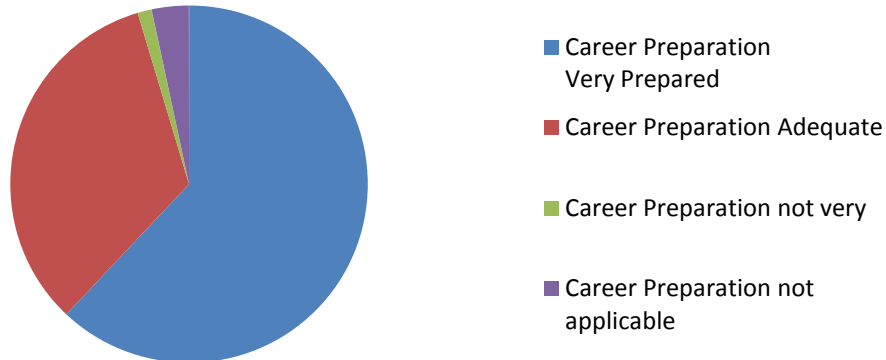
## Oklahoma City University Career Services, Placement Data – Class of 2010

**Methodology:** Undergraduate students were given questions to address on the application for graduation. These questions focused on internship experience, graduate school applications, career preparedness and employment upon graduation.

**Respondents:** 246 undergraduate students completed the survey.

**Career Preparedness** = 60% of students indicated that they were very prepared, 32% indicated that they were Adequately prepared and 1% indicated that they were not prepared.



**Graduate School:** Of the 246 students that completed the survey, 50% indicated that they are attending graduate school. Selected schools include, but are not limited to:

**Employment upon Graduation:** The class of 2010, 30.1% had employment offers prior to graduation. This is above the national average of 28%, according to the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) class survey.

**Internships:** 22% of the class of 2010 indicated that they completed at least one internship prior to graduation.

**Class of 2010 Data:** 50% applied to graduate school, 30.1% had job offer prior to graduation, 19.9% unknown.
