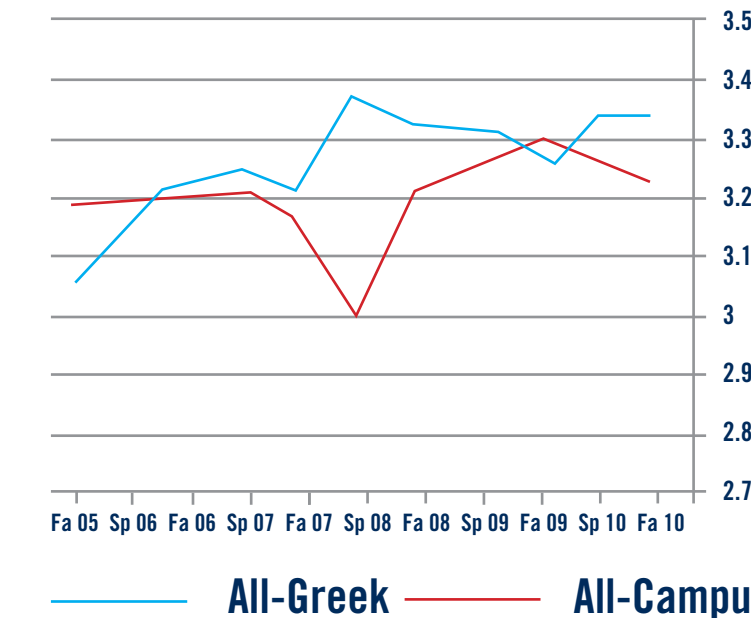
OCU Greeks Make the Grades!

PHILANTHROPY & COMMUNITY SERVICE

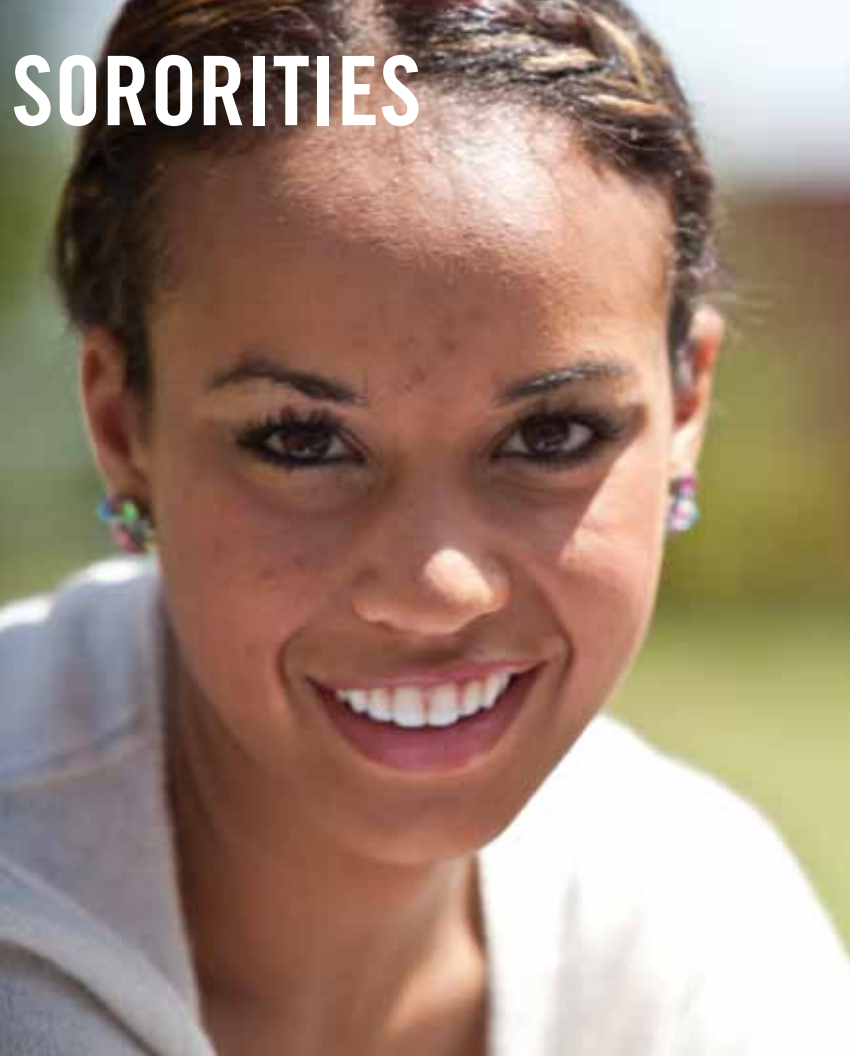
Be alert to give service. What counts a great deal in life is what we do for others.
