Campus Health is available to serve the OCU community Monday – Friday 8:00 am -5:00 pm or when the University is open. If you are ill outside of these times and find that you cannot wait until we re-open to get medical care, here are some options for you. This list is provided to you for your convenience. Physician choice is solely the patient's responsibility. Any bills generated at any clinic outside of the Campus Health Clinic are the responsibility of the patient. If you have health insurance, take your ID card with you. You may be expected to pay for all services at time of visit.
